## Profile

33 Bond was first conceived as a collaborative venture with free, art-punk mag *Cool'eh*. And while first-time gallerists Alix Frey, Mitchell Minskoff, and Rebecca Mirsky decided to open the tiny downtown space *sans* publication, the artwork in their inaugural exhibition still reflects the magazine's fun, hip aesthetic. Minskoff and Frey say they scoured more than 100 studios for the show which spotlights nine up-and-comers such as Andrew Kuo (3-D acrylics on layered paper), Yong Ho Ji (motorcycle-tire animal sculptures), and Philippe Nuell (large-scale oils).
